Is your child sleep starved?

An interesting study by the World Health Organisation reports a rise in the number of young people struggling with tiredness, inability to concentrate, mood swings and poor emotional well-being with strong links being made to insufficient sleep.

According to the Sleep Foundation children aged 6-13 years need **9-11 hours** sleep per night. So, if they are waking up at 7am then a bedtime of 8pm would be needed to fit in sufficient sleep hours. Children who routinely get less than this can experience behavioural issues, mood swings and difficulty with learning as well as an impact on physical and mental health. Food for thought...
