We had a number of parents reporting concerns at parents evening about the use of Tik Tok, Whatsapp and other apps. Despite the legal age for use of these apps being 13 it would appear that they are used widely by our children to communicate out of school hours. We have had reports of abusive language and bullying behaviour from a number of parents with children in KS2. We have children who are posting videos of themselves swearing, and being abusive to classmates which are open to any member of the public to view and circulate. Where we are able to identify the pupil and have evidence of this behaviour we will be contacting parents. However I would ask all parents to be mindful of their child's online presence and how they are conducting themselves as it would appear some of them are making poor choices which could have serious consequences. With the half term holiday coming up could I please ask that you take the time to discuss this serious issue with your child.
